# **ART GALLERY GETS A POWER SURGE!**

## **Art Gallery of S.A. displays 2004 AFL Premiership Cup**

Power fans will be surging into the Art Gallery of South Australia from today when the Gallery puts the 2004 AFL Premiership Cup on display.

Port Adelaide Football Club's inaugural Premiership cup has been admired by many at Alberton and regional South Australia since the historic win in September but now city-dwellers will have their chance to see the cup by visiting the Art Gallery on North Terrace.

"Some people might think it's strange that a sporting trophy is going on display in the Art Gallery... well, its no secret that I'm a mad keen Power fan" says Art Gallery Director, Ron Radford, "but the Gallery is one of the most visited attractions in our state showcasing all sorts of cultural treasures and we're pretty good at looking after priceless objects... when we suggested it to Port they were only too pleased".

And there's a precedent for this display: "in 1984 the Gallery hosted the America's Cup trophy and it was visited by over 63,000 people "says Radford. "I hope that just as many South Australians will turn out this time to celebrate this fantastic win for our state" he adds.
